Competencies for Activity Sign Off	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be able to manage a group of participants 2:15• Follow the Activity SOPs• Looking out for unsafe actions• Know where to get help/locate CYC Staff or group organizers• Demonstrate correct use of Flying Fox gear- Harnesses, Pulley, Karabiners, Straps• Demonstrate correct procedures• Read and understand Instructions• Observe instructor for 2 participants• Be observed by instructor for 5 participants
