<p>Competencies for Activity Sign Off</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be able to manage a group of participants 2:15 • Follow the Activity SOPs • Looking out for unsafe actions • Know where to get help/locate CYC Staff or group organizers • Demonstrate correct use of Flying Fox gear- Harnesses, Pulley, Karabiners, Straps • Demonstrate correct procedures • Read and understand Instructions • Observe instructor for 2 participants • Be observed by instructor for 5 participants
