# Archery - Risk Analysis and Management

<b>Emergency procedures</b> Stop activity, assess situation, administer first aid, call emergency services if necessary, notify camp organisers and camp staff	
<b>Equipment</b>	1 bow and 5 arrow per set Activity SOPs.
<b>Competencies for Activity Sign Off</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be able to manage a group of participants 1:15</li><li>• Follow the Activity Instructions</li><li>• Actively supervising the participants</li><li>• Looking out for unsafe actions</li><li>• Know where to get help/locate CYC Staff or group organizers</li><li>• Technical information</li></ul>
<b>Final decision on implementing activity</b>	<b>ACCEPTED by CYC Director</b>
<b>Comments</b> Circumstances can change quickly, supervisors need to be diligent in their task, and respond as needed.
