



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Archery

- 1 Activity Supervisor per 15 participants
- Never leave the archery equipment out or unattended
- Keep bows pointed towards the targets
- Someone with previous experience or trained by camp staff must supervise this activity
- All campers not shooting must stay behind those using the bows
- Campers to collect their arrows once all shooters have finished their turn, and bows are on the ground
- If you are the last group on for the day, please return bows and arrows to CYC Staff
- No shooting if animals are behind the targets
- Do not dry fire the bows (an unloaded bow)

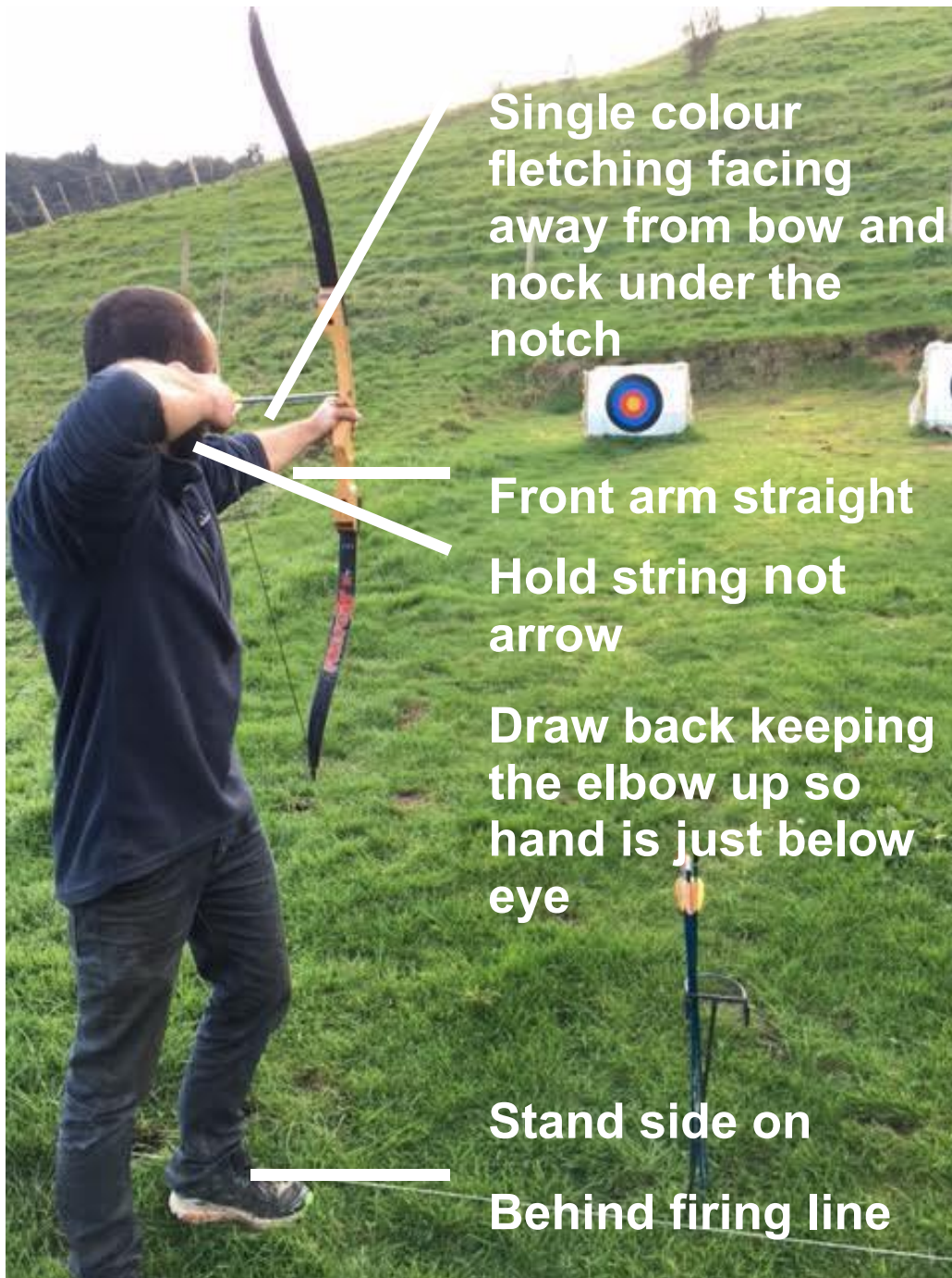
All damage and injuries must be reported to Camp Leaders and CYC Staff as soon as practical

Technique



- Aim
- Shoot
- Wait till all bows are on the ground before retrieving the arrows
- Pull arrows out straight and close to the tip
- Walk back with arrow point facing downwards until you get beyond the firing line
- Place arrows back in stand
