



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Archery

- 1 Activity Supervisor per 12 participants.
- Supervisors are not allowed to be distracted; this means minimal use of phones.
- Never leave the archery equipment out or unattended.
- Keep bows pointed towards the targets.
- Use Technique diagram.
- Wrist guards are provided on request, keep the forward arm slightly bent – elbow pointing out to the side to prevent injury.
- All campers not shooting must stay behind those using the bows, on the green turf or in the shelter.
- Campers to collect their arrows once all shooters have finished their turn, and bows are placed down.
- Walk to the targets, do not run.
- For the last group of the day, the Supervisor must take equipment back to designated area.
- No shooting if animals are behind the targets.
- Do not dry fire the bows (an unloaded bow).
- Wear sunblock on fine days.


All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable

Technique



- Aim
- Shoot
- Wait till all bows are on the ground before retrieving the arrows
- Walk to the targets, do not run.
- Pull arrows out straight and close to the tip
- Point arrow tips down towards the ground while walking
- Walk back behind the firing line
