



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Arrow Tag

- 1 Activity Supervisor per 12 participants.
- All Activity Supervisors to be trained by a CYC Instructor.
- Supervisors are not allowed to be distracted - minimal use of phones.
- All participants must wear masks during the game.
- Be careful of obstacles and bunkers.
- Do not aim at the head. Headshots do not count.
- Covered Shoes are required (crocs do not count).
- Do not use arrows that are missing the foam head or are damaged in any way.
- Activity Supervisor must stop the game if anyone is without a mask in the playing field.
- All observers to stay in the shelter away from the playing field.
- Observers outside shelter must wear masks.
- Participants under 8 years of age are recommended to only shoot targets.
- Respect the right of participants to stop and sit this activity out.
- Do not shoot from less than 3 meters away.
- Participants can tag with hands at close distances.
- Avoid swapping masks during the rotation.
- Spray masks with disinfectant after each use.
- Archery – Arrow Tag is done only on the paintball course at the south end of camp near the BMX track or the set field location, unless prior approval given.
- Wrist guards are provided on request, keep the forward arm slightly bent – elbow pointing out to the side to prevent injury.
- Do not dry fire the bows (an unloaded bow).
- Never leave the archery equipment out or unattended.
- Do not undergo manoeuvres on the course that could damage gear, e.g. rolls or dives with bows. Avoid walking on arrows.
- Allow time before the end of the session to find all the arrows, count them before and after the session.
- Wear sunblock on fine days.

All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable.

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.
