



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Burma Trail

- 1 Activity Supervisor per 15 participants
- Extra care must be taken if this activity is done blind folded or at night
- Covered shoes must be worn
- Rope and track needs to be checked for obstacles, branches, wasps, tripping hazards and that the rope is complete and in place before participant's start
- Supervisors must be stationed along the rope to be watching and listening for participants that may be injured or distressed
- Participants should be encouraged to 'give it a go' but not coerced
- This should not be a timed activity and participants encouraged to complete it at their own pace

All damage and injuries must be reported to Camp Leaders and CYC Staff as soon as practical

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.
