



## SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

# Burma Trail

- 1 Activity Supervisor per 12 participants
- Extra care must be taken if this activity is done blind folded or at night
- Covered shoes must be worn
- There are two difficulties for the track which can be shown by CYC staff.
- The rope and track needs to be checked for obstacles, branches, wasps, tripping hazards and that the rope is complete and in place before participants start
- Supervisors must be stationed along the rope to be watching and listening for participants that may be injured or distressed
- Participants should be encouraged to 'give it a go' but not coerced into participation
- This should not be a timed activity and participants encouraged to complete it at their own pace
- When Undertaking during the day, reapply sunblock regularly on fine days

**All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable**

**Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.**
