



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Campfire/ Cookout

- 1 Activity Supervisor 16 years or older per 12 participants.
- Fires are only to be lit with CYC permission as there may be a fire ban in operation.
- Covered shoes must be worn .
- Make certain there is water/extinguishers nearby for fires that may be out of control or in case of burns.
- Supervisors must make certain the campers know the dangers of fires and very hot equipment.
- If skewers or other objects are used for damper or marshmallows participants must be closely monitored and be reminded by Supervisor to not play or run around with the skewers.
- Supervisors to be watching for hazardous or dangerous behaviour and prevent or stop it.
- Fires must be supervised at all times.
- Fires must be put out at end of activity.

All damage and injuries must be reported to Camp Leaders and CYC Staff as soon as practicable.

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.

CYC reserve the right to close this activity if these instructions are not followed.
