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Terrain: Uneven ground & Tripping Hazards	9	M	Mow long grass to prevent hidden objects or topography from going unnoticed Wear covered shoes to prevent tripping or injuring feet	2	Campers confined to mown areas Must wear covered shoes	Yes
Bridge: falling off temporary bridge	8	M	One at a time on bridge Controlled crossing by supervisor over 16 Make use of railing	5	One at a time on temporary bridge Controlled crossing by supervisor over 16, Use railing	Yes
Environment: stream bordering property	5	M	Familiarize supervisors with area and inform of potential water risk	5	Supervisors familiar with campout area Campers confined to mown areas	Yes
People: Impairment of Supervisor	6	E	CYC Staff to look out for signs of impairment	3	-	Yes
