



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Camp-out

- 3 Activity Supervisors per 30 participants
- Vehicles driving into camp-out must do a u-turn in a safe place and enter gate turning left
- Check ability and potential health risks of the group before leaving
- All walkers must have appropriate gear including clothing and First aid kit e.g. plasters, strapping tape, bug repellent, antihistamine etc and any required medication
- A Supervisor must carry some form of communication device
- When accessing area by foot, do so only via foot path and rail trail walkway only, do not access via main road
- Must wear covered shoes
- Supervisors to be familiar with camp-out area
- One at a time on temporary bridge, controlled crossing by supervisor over 16, Use railing
- Campers to be confined to mown areas only
- Stay off the main road
- Keep area clean and tidy when vacating
- Small flash floods can occur. Move all guests back to the main camp if wet weather persists or there are any signs of creek water level rising.

All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable. Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.
