



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Canyoning

- 1 Activity Supervisor per 15 participants
- Covered shoes must be worn. They will get wet.
- There must be a competent supervisor who is leading the canyoning
- If participants are climbing waterfall, correct spotting technique must be used
- The supervisor must be familiar with the canyon and take a cell phone
- Someone at camp must know start times and estimated time of return
- Other supervisors must be spread throughout the group to maintain motivation and control
- All participants must have appropriate gear including footwear, first aid, and clothing
- Keep to the stream. If you can't see the stream, you've gone too far

All damage and injuries must be reported to Camp Leaders and CYC Staff as soon as practical

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.
