



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Extreme Stream

- 2 Supervisors over 16 years old, per 12 participants.
- Covered shoes must be worn, shoes will get wet.
- There must be a competent supervisor who is leading the activity
- The supervisors must be familiar with the stream and take a cell phone.
- Other supervisors must be spread throughout the group to maintain motivation and control (Supervisor at the back to catch stragglers).
- When participants climb the waterfalls, use the ropes provided and good spotting techniques with body posture for supporting others as they do this activity- arms up, front foot forward and ready to brace shoulders.
- Take care all the time as ground is uneven and slippery.
- Someone at camp must know start times and estimated time of return.
- All participants must have appropriate gear including footwear, first aid, and clothing.
- Keep to the stream. If you can't see the stream, you've gone too far
- Once you reach the fork in the stream head left towards wooden bridge, once on the path walk left towards camp, stay to track and don't deviate.
- Helmets to be worn at all times.
- Do a head count before and after Extreme Stream.

All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.
