



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Hydro-slide

- 2 Activity Supervisor per 30 participants
- One adult must be supervising launching deck, and one supervising the landing pool, at all times
- Supervising adult at landing pool must be holding the rescue pole.
- Life jackets available for non-confident swimmers
- One or two person/s at a time on slide per mat
- Sliders must slide on a mat and go feet first
- Next slider starts only when landing pool is clear
- Back person to have hands on front persons shoulders
- Caution: Pool is 1.2m deep – non-confident swimmers must wear a life jacket if under this height
- Do not use detergent on the slide
- Return mats to the box
- Expectant mothers or participants with injured backs should not slide

All damage and injuries must be reported to Camp Leaders and CYC Staff as soon as practical

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.
