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Equipment: Running into obstacles Shooting to close	12	M	Advise participants to be careful And not to shoot too close	6	Be careful of obstacles Paintball is done only in the paintball course at the south end of camp near the BMX track No shooting at players closer than 4 body lengths away Do not aim at the head	Yes
Equipment: Germs on masks	12	E	Disinfect masks after each use	4	Spray masks with disinfectant after each use	Yes
