



SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE

Pond

- 2 Activity Supervisors over 16 years old and able to swim, per 12 swimmers
- Life Jackets must be put on and fitted correctly by a supervisor
- Life jackets to be worn at all times with appropriate clothing e.g. togs or lightweight sportswear
- Participants must be confident swimmers
- The rope separating the flying fox is the upstream boundary for the swimmers, No swimmers past rope boundary
- One adult must be on the water, preferably in a kayak, and one adult keeping an eye on participants from the shore and checking life jackets
- No running during this activity, or along the waterfront/wharf due to slipping hazard
- No play fighting or dangerously pushing other participants of pontoon or wharf
- Supervisors must assist children when getting out of the lake/pond around hard areas to exit
- At the end of the session/day please carry all lifejackets back to the kayak shed
- Hang life jackets up to aid in drying
- Keep swimmers away from boats and obstacles
- Make sure participants have been to the toilet prior to activity

**All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable
Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.**
