People: Emotional harm due to being shot at	12	M	Under 8 years not recommended to shoot each other Option to sit this activity out or to shoot at targets instead	6	It is a CYC recommendation that children 8 years and under only shoot targets not each other Respect the right of players to stop and sit this activity out	Yes
Equipment: Running into obstacles Shooting too close	12	M	Advise participants to be careful And not to shoot at each other at close range Only play paintball in designated areas unless prior approval given and new RAM created for that area. Must wear sturdy shoes to prevent slipping or tripping	6	Be careful of obstacles Shotgun Paintball is done only on the paintball course at the south end of camp near the BMX track, unless prior approval given No shooting at players closer than 4 body lengths away, Tag with hands at close distances Do not aim at the head Covered shoes are required (crocs do not count)	Yes

People: Poor supervision	12	M	Supervised activity	4	1 Activity Supervisor per 15 participants No paintball to be fired until session starts and none to be fired after session finishes All paintballs to be left on course, and not brought back into camp! Check pockets to be sure	Yes
People: Impairment of Supervisor	6	E	CYC Staff to look out for signs of impairment	3	-	Yes
Equipment: Damage to equipment	1	M	Do not use paintball bullets left on the ground Do not undergo manoeuvres on the course that could damage gear CYC Staff to check prior to putting out gear	1	Do not use paintball bullets left on the ground, due water and sunlight damage that will cause blockages in guns Do not undergo manoeuvres on the course that could damage gear, e.g. roles or dives with shotguns	Yes
