



**SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURE
CYC INSTRUCTED ACTIVITY
Target Shooting**

- 1 CYC Instructor and 1 guest Supervisor over 16 years old, per 12 participants
- Treat every firearm as loaded.
- Always point firearms in a safe direction.
- Make sure firing range is roped off.
- CYC instructor to make sure firing range is clear before giving an all clear to fire.
- No shooting if animals/people are behind the targets.
- Always hold rifle as demonstrated by instructor, ask for help if needed.
- Make sure pellet has cleared the barrel before reloading.
- Anyone not shooting must stay behind those using the rifles.
- Only go into the firing range once every rifle is unloaded, on the bench, and anyone not resetting targets is seated on the provided seats.
- Keep fingers away from the trigger when loading.
- Make sure fingers are kept clear of barrel hinge when closed.
- Rifles should be unloaded when not in use and before putting away.
- Never leave the air rifles out or unattended.
- Instructor to lock up guns when unattended.

All damage and injuries must be reported to CYC Staff as soon as practicable

Failure to follow these instructions could result in injury.

Technique

1. Make sure the target area is clear of people
2. Cock the Air Rifle
3. Load the Air Rifle
4. Close the Air Rifle
5. Place the Air Rifle down without breaking the barrel
6. Aim, make sure the target area is clear of people
7. Take off safety
8. Shoot
9. Place rifle on bench or repeat procedure
